



## Merit Based Scholarship Application 2018-2019 The Greater Lansing Islamic School (GLIS) invites applicants to

### *Dr. Mohamed Hassan Elnabtity and Family Scholarship*

#### Eligibility:

- Open to students who will enroll in GLIS in the year 2018-2019 at grades 1<sup>st</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup>.
- Students who are currently in GLIS as well as new students are eligible.
- For students who are currently in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade and above, the student's grades in all subjects in the previous two years should be at least at the level of B (or equivalent).
- Students who receive other scholarships are not eligible.
- The family annual income should not exceed the amount shown below.

**Selection Criteria:** Academic potential, Islamic behavior in and out of school, and need. When all factors are equal, preference will be given to new students and to students whose families are active at the Greater Lansing Masjid and/or School.

**Deadline:** Applications are due in the School office by **4 PM on Friday, May 25<sup>th</sup>**.

1. Complete one Scholarship Application form for each applicant.
2. Attach copies of grade report cards (at least the last two years for students in 2<sup>nd</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> grades).
3. Students in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade and above should write an essay titled "Why I deserve the scholarship"
4. You may also attach any supporting documents such as:
  - Recommendation letters from teachers, principals, Imams, youth-group leaders, etc.
  - Copies of certificates of recognition or awards;
  - Copy of the most recent M STEP or Stanford Achievement Test (if applicable).
  - 1040 tax return form for 2017 or pay slip for the current year must be submitted.

## **Criteria for Merit Based Scholarship at GLIS**

1. It is expected that students who receive a merit based scholarship exemplify excellent moral behavior and leadership in school and outside of school.
2. Students must arrive at school in a timely manner and not be absent more than five (5) days per quarter. Additionally scholarship students should not be tardy more than five (5) times per quarter. If the student has a legitimate reason for absences or tardies, student's families must present documentation which support their absences.
3. Students must be respectful of the administration and those adults employed to supervise them.
4. Students must maintain at least a B average. If the grade point average drops below a C+, the student is not eligible for a merit scholarship the following year and cannot submit a scholarship application to GLIS.
