## Math

### Everdayday Folders

**Your student has a GREEN Everyday Folder. Inside every night will be any homework they have (anything they didn't finish in class). Students will also have a post it with their Math IXL on it for the week.**

### Language Arts

Students have been working hard on Unit 5 over the past two weeks. Students have been reading about different cultures. They have learned that even though cultures may be different, they also have similarities as well.

Students receive a copy of the spelling words/challenge words as well as the vocabulary words on Monday on the information sheet.

### Science

Students have completed Chapter 3: Plants. Students will take the **Test on Monday, April 30<sup>th</sup>**. Students should study over the weekend using their book and review.

Students completed Chapter 10: Fractions. They brought their tests home on Friday. Students struggled somewhat with fraction concepts. Inshaallah, we will continue to discuss them as the year continues. Students started Chapter 13: Perimeter and Area (we will go back to Chapters 11&12).

Multiplication quizzes will take place every Wednesday. Students are moving at their own pace. **\*\*\*Please remind your child to practice their multiplication for 5 minutes every night. It will help them a lot!\*\*\***

### Math & Language Arts IXL

**Students are assigned IXL homework every week for both math and language arts. They have an information sheet given to them on Monday of each week with these written on it that are due the following Monday.**

The past two weeks, students have continued practicing their map skills over the past two weeks. We have been focusing mostly on Science. Inshaallah, we will finish our few remaining Michigan Community Studies Weekly newspapers.
