Math

Everdayday Folders

Your student has a GREEN Everyday Folder. Inside every night will be any homework they have (anything they didn't finish in class). Students will also have a post it with their Math IXL on it for the week.

Language Arts

Students have completed Unit 3 last week. This week, we reviewed concepts from the unit including verbs, contractions, prefixes, suffixes, and silent letters in words. Students completed the Unit 3 Assessment on Friday of this week. Next week, we will begin Unit 4. Spelling Tests and Vocab Quizzes will continue then.

Students receive a copy of the spelling words/challenge words as well as the vocabulary words on Monday on the information sheet.

If students have any missing or low IXL, they should try to complete it over break. We did spend some time on Thursday in class this week working on it.

Science

Students have been learning about Weather and Climate. Students learned the difference between weather and climate last week. This week, students learned about different tools used to measure wind, humidity, temperature, and air pressure.

Students been completed Chapter 6 this week. They took the Test on Thursday. Students are beginning Chapter 7: Multiplication and Division.

Multiplication quizzes will take place every Wednesday. Students are moving at their own pace; some students are on their 2's, while others will be on their 8's next week. *****Please remind your child to practice their multiplication for 5 minutes every night. It will help them a lot!*****

Math & Language Arts IXL

Students are assigned IXL homework every week for both math and language arts. They have an information sheet given to them on Monday of each week with these written on it that are due the following Monday.

Social Studies

The past two weeks, students learned about different regions of the United States including the Pacific Region and Hawaii. Students also learned how people examine history as well as the American Indians, Past and Present, in Michigan.
