Math

Everdayday Folders

Your student has a GREEN Everyday Folder. Inside every night will be any homework they have (anything they didn't finish in class). Students will also have a post it with their Math IXL on it for the week.

Language Arts

We have completed Unit 2! Students spent this short week reviewing and we will also review content from this unit next week.

Students will take the Unit 2 Assessment next Friday, December 1st. This will be just like Unit 1. I will grade it, but it will NOT affect your student's grade. This is done so I can assess how well the class understood topics we have already covered. If I notice multiple students still don't understand a topic, I will make sure we practice it more. ***There is NO way to study for this except to complete all assigned work.***

Students receive a copy of the spelling words/challenge words as well as the vocabulary words on Monday on the information sheet.

Science

Students completed Chapter 1: Force and Motion last week. This week, we began Chapter 2: Energy and Its Forms.

We have been working on Chapter 4: Understanding Multiplication. Students have been learning about equal groups, arrays, and the Commutative Property of Multiplication ($3 \times 4 = 12$ and $4 \times 3 = 12$).

Multiplication quizzes will take place every Wednesday. Students have all passed their 0's and 1's. Students took their 2's multiplication quiz on Wednesday of this week.

Math & Language Arts IXL

Students are assigned IXL homework every week for both math and language arts. They have an information sheet given to them on Monday of each week with these written on it that are due the following Monday.

Social Studies

Students learned about economics in Michigan. They learned about scarcity and entrepreneurs. Students learned about different features of a map to help them read and understand maps including learning about the many waterways of the United States. This year we will only be doing our Studies Weekly newspapers, weekly Geography Packets, and brainpopjr.com videos and quizzes.
