Math

Everdayday Folders

Your student has a GREEN Everyday Folder. Inside every night will be any homework they have (anything they didn't finish in class). Students will also have a post it with their Math IXL on it for the week.

Language Arts

We have been working on Unit 2 these past couple of weeks. We have our final week of the Unit coming up. Then we will have a review week and complete the End of the Unit Test following the review.

Students should also be reading daily at home and recording it on their Reading Log. I collect the Reading Logs at the end of the month.

Please make sure students are studying spelling words over the week and vocabulary words over the weekend.

Students receive a copy of the spelling words/challenge words as well as the vocabulary words on Monday on the information sheet.

Science

Students have been working on Chapter 1: Force and Motion over the past three weeks. We will review the chapter next week and have the **Chapter 1 Test on Thursday, 11/16/17.**

We have been working on Chapter 3: Subtraction. Students completed the Chapter 3 Test on Thursday of this week. They will receive an updated Progress Report next week for Math. We will start Chapter 4: Understanding Multiplication on Monday.

Multiplication quizzes will take place every Wednesday. We will be starting this next week, beginning with 0's and 1's.

Math & Language Arts IXL

Students are assigned IXL homework every week for both math and language arts. They have an information sheet given to them on Monday of each week with these written on it that are due the following Monday.

Social Studies

Students learned about natural resources Michigan has to offer, including the Great Lakes! Students learned about different features of a map to help them read and understand maps including picturing North America and different types of transportation routes. This year we will only be doing our Studies Weekly newspapers and weekly Geography Packets.
