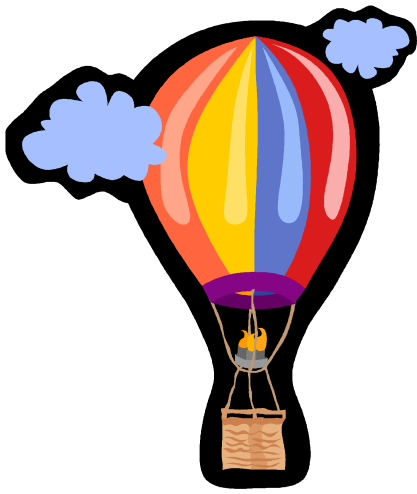

Mathematics
