Figurative Language: Hyperbole, Idiom

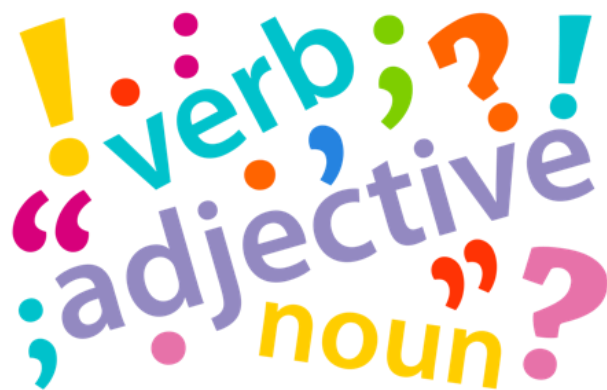
Conventions: Possessive Pronouns
