The students took a quiz about the second set then we started with the new chapter about "Shirk"

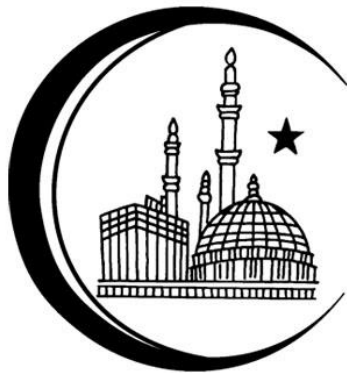
