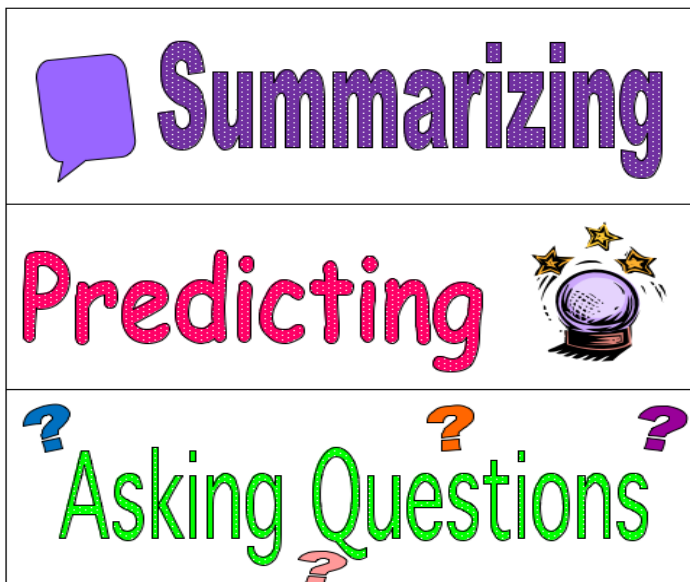
## Language Arts (ELA)

Dear Parents Assalamu-alaikum,

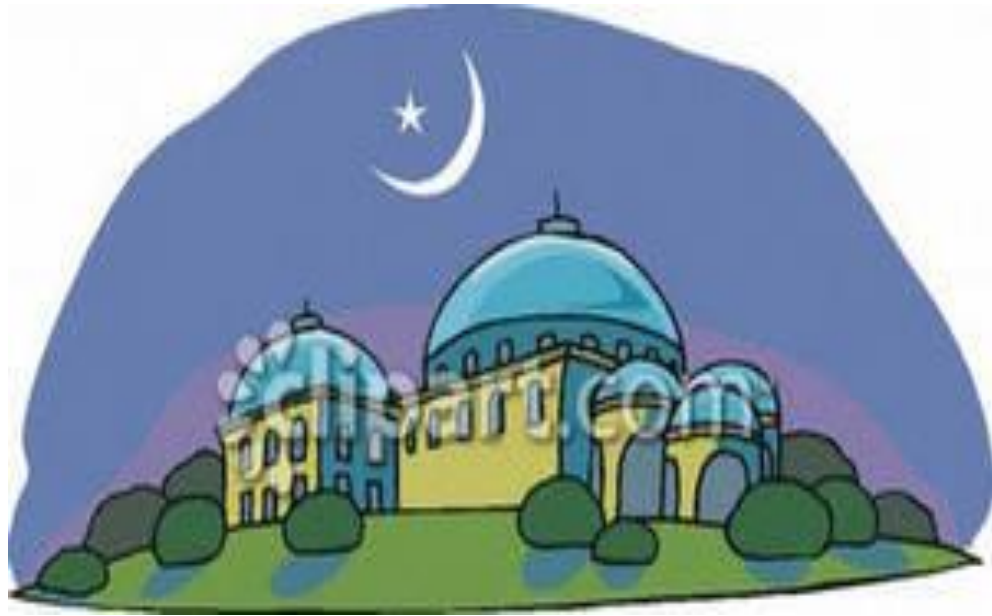
