

### Book 3

- We continued working on lesson 8 (How do you make desert?) reading, and solving work book exercises, learning new vocabulary words about adjectives. We learned about pronouns that are suffixed to the end of nouns to express the meaning of possessive relationship like:

هذا كتابي – هذا كتابها – هذا كتابه – هذا كتابك
