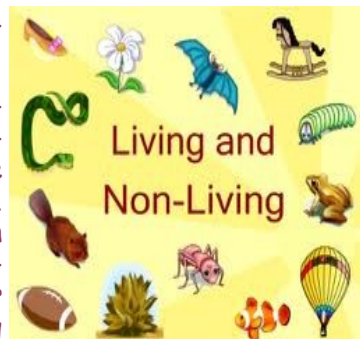
Assalaamualaikum,
